There is mandatory orientation for all volunteers.

Major Objective: Strong desire to help animals and support local events such as: More Love by the Pound, Low Cost Vaccination Events, Tag Day, Adopt-A-Thon, Be Kind to Animals Week, National Dog Bite Prevention Week, Take Your Dog to Work Day, Art for the Animals, National



Responsibilities:

- Assist with set-up/breakdown of event.
- Distribute educational handouts, volunteer applications, and brochures to visitors.
- Walk animals during the event.
- Make baskets, crafts, etc., prior to event.
- All other duties as required by the Event Coordinator.

Training:

- Complete Volunteer Application
- Interview with Volunteer Coordinator
- Attend Volunteer Orientation
- Specialized training with clinic supervisor and/or volunteer coordinator.

Commitment:

- Volunteer a minimum of 8 hours a month participate in the program for one year, read and follows SOP, always checks in and out on the sign in sheet.

Supervision:

- Direct supervision by event coordinator and/or volunteer coordinator.
