Shot Clinic Hours Revised; Fridays Now Offered by Animal Services

Vaccination times at the Riverside shelter now include Fridays, Riverside County Chief Veterinarian Dr. Allan Drusys said.

But the vaccination time slots have changed and those familiar with the old hours of service will want to take note, Drusys suggested.

The new hours are: Tuesday through Friday, 9 a.m. to noon at the Riverside Shelter, 5950 Wilderness Ave., Riverside, Calif. 92504.

Vaccination prices are the same. For dogs, rabies shots are \$6. Treating bordatella, also known as kennel cough, is \$6. A distemper/parvo vaccination is \$9.

Cat vaccinations shot prices are \$18 for tapeworm, \$14 for cat distemper, \$10 for feline leukemia, and \$6 for the Corona virus.

The Riverside Shelter also schedules low cost vaccination clinics once a month on Saturdays. The next one is scheduled on Sept. 15.
